PROGRAM RESOURCES

Greetings from the western U.P. We've adjusted to the change of our district's name to Northern Skies.

Now we are doing another "new thing." My name is Bonnie Picotte. I've been serving on the district Nominations Committee. But now I am the new Secretary of Program Resources. I was told that it will be a simplified version of what this position has been in the past. All of the details will be worked out during this period of transition.

The reading plans, 1-4, will be essentially the same as previous years.

- *Plan 1: Read 5 books each year. (1 book from each category)
- *Plan 2: Read 10 books each year. (2 books from each category)
- *Plan 3: Read 15 books each year. (2 books from each category, plus 5 additional books from any category)
- *Plan 4: Read 20 books each year. (2 books from each category, plus 10 additional books from any category)
- *Regular reading of Response magazine is suggested for each of the reading plans.
- *Bonus books are credited toward the reading plan as the equivalent of 2 books.

*Faith Talks podcasts: Listening to 2 episodes of Faith Talks counts as the equivalent of 1 book. Listen to 3 Faith Talks podcasts and it will count as 2 books in the category of Spiritual Growth.

The reading list for 2023 includes books from the 2018 list through the 2023 list.

There are still the same 5 categories of books. I will give recommendations with each one.

Education for mission: *Phoebe*: A Story by Paula Gooder; *The Book Woman of Troublesome Creek* by Kim Michele Richardson.

Leadership Development: *On the Come Up* by Angie Thomas; *Becoming* by Michelle Obama

Nurturing for Community: *The Hidden Life - Awakened* by Kitty Crenshaw and Cathy Snapp, PhD; *Fire Keeper's Daughter* by Angeline Boulley.

Social Action: *Caste* (Bonus book) by Isabel Wilkerson; *The Four Winds* by Kristin Hannah.

Spiritual Growth: Sleep, Pray, Heal: a path to wholeness and well-being by Donna Fado Ivery; The Big Deal of Taking Small Steps to Move Closer to GOD by Bishop Vashti Murphy McKenzie.
